GAME START TIME: 7:00pm

***The stadium gates will open for admission by 6:00 p.m.

- SITE: Herb Meyer Stadium 400 Rancho Del Oro Drive Oceanside, CA 92057 Phone: 757-8550
- DIRECTIONS: I-5 North 76 East Right on Rancho Del Oro Right on "Wildcat Way" into lower parking lot.
- **PARKING:** Visitor parking is available in the lower student parking lot near the stadium. If the lower lot is full, security staff will direct spectators to the upper, staff parking lot. Please provide a list of visiting administrators so that we can reserve parking near the stadium.
- **BUSES:** 1. Team buses will unload and park at the southeast most end of the lower parking lot nearest the gym. ECHS security staff will direct them to the parking area when they arrive.

ADMISSION: Visitor seating is located on the south side of the stadium. CIFSDS and CIF Press passes are accepted for admittance.

> Visiting spectators will purchase tickets at the main gate ticket booth and then proceed down the hill to the right to the visitor's gate.

LOCKER ROOMS: Visiting teams will have the **girl's PE locker room** available to them before the game, at half time, and after the game if needed. The girl's locker room is located on the south east end of the gym/locker room complex

Visiting team will leave and enter the field using the ramp at the east end of the field. The ramp leads directly up to the locker rooms. <u>Please make sure the athletes remain on the mats covering the track.</u>

<u>Please ensure that a member of your staff is present inside the locker</u> room with your athletes at all times.

FIELD/TRACK Considerations:

1) Please ensure that your athletes cross the track on the mats provided to limit damage to the track surface caused by cleats.

2) NO VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE STADIUM AT ANY TIME.

3) The visiting school's athletic trainer and equipment manager can access the emergency vehicle access road at the west end of the stadium, drop off items near the end of the track, and then park their vehicles elsewhere. A cart will be made available inside the stadium to move items from the drop of point to the sideline.

4) Only water is allowed on the sideline during games. There should be no eating of sunflower seeds, use of chewing tobacco, eating, etc on the field at any time.

PRESS BOX: The visiting team will use the west end of the upper (outdoor) press box. A maximum of four personnel will be allowed in the

press box. This includes coaches, filmers, etc. No parents allowed in the press box at any time. **Visiting school is responsible for their own wireless headsets.**

- **FILMING:** The videographer must accompany the coaches onto the pressbox. One end zone camera with one videographer will be allowed at the east end of the field.
- **ROSTERS:** Please email a copy of your varsity roster for our announcer prior to the contest so that it can be entered in our game program. You may email your roster to our athletic director at sean.helgesen@oside.k12.ca.us. You can also fax the roster to 760-433-4954.
- **WARM-UP:** The visiting team will conduct pre-game warm-up on the east end of the field, furthest from the scoreboard.

Visiting school will have access to the field for warm ups approximately one hour before kick off.

- **UNIFORMS:** El Camino Varsity will wear dark brown jerseys for home games. Visiting teams must wear light colored jerseys.
- **CHEERLEADERS:** Cheerleaders in uniform will be admitted free. Cheerleaders must be accompanied by an advisor.

Cheerleaders cannot use any ladders or stools on the track surface. If they are to use boxes, the bottoms must be covered in felt or carpet.

- **PEP BAND:** Pep band members, if applicable, will be admitted free if they are wearing a band uniform, a T-shirt or something identifying. All pep band members must enter at the same time with the advisor.
- **SECURITY:** OUSD provides an extensive security staff for all home contests. Uniformed Oceanside Police Department officers will also be on hand. El Camino administration will also be present to deal with any issues that may arise.
- **MEDICAL STAFF:** A physician and an athletic trainer will be available for injury and emergency situations during game time. An ambulance and EMT's will also be onsite during warm ups and for the duration of the game.

CONCESSIONS: The concession stand in the southwest corner of the facility will be open for visiting fans.

RESTROOMS: The restrooms located in the southwest corner of the stadium will be open for use by the visiting fans.
