View your high school student's cumulative transcript.

Email Notification
Receive various email notifications from the school.

School Bulletin
Read daily announcements.

My Calendars
Subscribe to your student's class assignments, scores, and final grades calendars. (iCal calendar/)

Change your profile information, and add students to your account.







3. In the Create Parent Account area at the top of this window, enter *your* name, email address, a Desired Username that you will enter every time you log in to the Parent Portal, and a Password that you will enter every time you log in to the Parent Portal.
The password must be 7 characters or more.
